- 3. Work entered in a class other than the distinct class to which such work belongs will be disqualified. Entry may be transferred into proper class on application to the Secretary. The numbers supplied by the Secretary must be securely attached to the exhibits. Every care will be taken, but the Committee will not be responsible for mistakes.
- 4. Reasonable care will be taken of all articles exhibited, but the Committee will not be accountable for any loss, damage, or injury that may occur to any exhibit before, during, or after the Show.
- 5. All persons entering the Exhibition Marquees are subject to the direction of the Stewards and the Secretary.
- 6. The decision of the judges as to the merits of exhibits shall in all cases be final.
- 7. Exhibitors are responsible for placing their exhibits in the appropriate section of the exhibition tent.
- 8. Exhibits in Schools / children's section to be left in the Home Industries tent at the show grounds between **2pm and 5.15pm Thursday**, **6th June**, **as judging will take place on Friday 7th June**.
